Chiltepin Entertainment LLC presents a limited engagement of the new musical *Monarch: A Mexican-American Musical* by Mexican composer Alfonso Molina and playwright Mayu Molina Lehmann. After successful performances in LA earlier this year retelling the undocumented immigrant journey in a positive light, *Monarch* returns, this time to the Los Angeles Theatre Center (LATC) from December 9 — 11. Performances will be in English.

In an interview with Mexico's Reforma newspaper, Alfonso Molina, educated at the Manhattan School of Music, said: "How is it possible that we don't have a musical that tells our story in the US?" His sister Mayu Molina Lehmann, a writer, agreed. The siblings then embarked on this journey to tell stories they knew well, having grown up on the border between Mexico and the US. The musical is told from the perspective of Mexican immigrants, highlighting the challenges they face, while presenting them in a positive light and their contributions to the US.

Monarch tells the story of beloved handyman Luis who, thanks to his hard work, runs a successful workshop for 20 years. Ana, his daughter, arrived in the US as a child and has grown up in the shadows, as have many of the thousands of "Dreamers" in this country. Their relatively calm lives are disrupted when Luis becomes the relentless focus of ICE officer Castelo. Fearing for his future, Luis seeks sanctuary in a local church where memories abound of the Monarch sanctuary in Mexico where he met his wife. Like the Monarch butterfly, Luis is determined to follow his fate-defining journey.

ABOUT THE CAST

The 12-member cast of Mexican professional performers is led by acclaimed actors Horacio Castelo, Carmen Gozz, Marco Salazar, and Maria Ayuso.

Horacio Castelo, renowned Mexican actor of TV, film, and theater, has worked extensively in TV for Televisa, appeared in 50+ feature films in Mexico, and most recently played the villain Lolo Lozada in the international Emmy Award winning Netflix series, *El Vato*. Instagram @elhoracio

ABOUT THE CREATORS

Mayu Molina Lehmann (book and lyrics) hails from Sonora, Mexico. **Lehmann** spent her academic years studying in France, Chile, and her native Sonora. She is the author of the bilingual book *A New Life for Candy / Una Nueva Vida para Candy* (available on Amazon), and a young adult novel *La Hija del Candidato*. *Monarch* is her first work for the stage. **Lehmann** worked at the Organization of American States (OAS) in Washington, D.C. and later as an interpreter helping immigrant families integrate into the school system. She is a member of Congregation Action Network a non-profit organization supporting immigrants' rights and was part of a team that created courses for recently arrived immigrants. **Lehmann** graduated with honors from Tec de Monterrey with a BA in Spanish Literature and Latin American studies. She is trilingual speaking Spanish, English, and French.

Alfonso Molina (music, lyrics, book) was born in Sonora, Mexico and has written several pieces encompassing Hispanic themes. **Molina** is a recipient of the 2022 Sistema Nacional de Creadores de Arte (SNCA), Mexico's most prestigious arts' grant which is bestowed who have rendered outstanding services through their work to the creative identity of Mexico. Earlier this year, he received the distinctive honor of being hand-picked by Mexico's most revered living composer, Arturo Márquez, to premiere one of his pieces alongside him. **Molina** obtained his Master of Music in Composition at the Manhattan School of Music. He received a Doctorate of Musical Arts (D.M.A.) from the University of Arizona. In 2019 **Molina** received a scholarship from the Carolina Foundation to study Musical Visual Arts at Cataluña's Superior School of Music (ESMUC) in Barcelona, Spain. His work has received multiple awards, including from ASCAP, The Boston Metro Opera (BMO), the National Fund for Culture and Arts of Mexico (FONCA-CONACYT) among others (www.alfonsomolina.com).
